



The school hours for the 2025-2026 school year are as follows:



FOR SALE / FOR LEASE SIGN POLICY

As you prepare to sell your home, we understand your eagerness to attract potential buyers, and we want to ensure a smooth and visually appealing process for everyone.

To maintain the aesthetic standards and safety of our neighborhood, please be aware that there are specific guidelines for "For Sale/For Lease" signs that must be followed. These guidelines help to ensure uniformity, prevent obstruction of views, and maintain property values.

- Real estate "For Sale/For Lease" signage must be approved Heartwood signage.
- "For Sale/For Lease" templates may be customized with your Real Estate Agent's Company Name, Name, and Phone Number.
- One approved "For Sale/For Lease" sign may be placed on a lot.
- No additional signage is permitted.
- Directional signage is not permitted.

POLICY ENFORCEMENT

Please note that Heartwood's **Resale/Lease Sign Policy** will begin to be **enforced 30 days from July 22, 2025.** For anyone who currently has a home listed for sale or lease, or is considering selling please ensure that your real estate agent knows that all resale signs on your property must comply with the established guidelines by **August 21, 2025.** The Resale Sign policy can be found in your resident portal.
